## WC5 Field Hockey Meeting August 18, 2022 minutes

President Flick opened the meeting at 7:30 p.m.

WC5 Financial Bulletin indicates that officials shall pay 5% for all games to the assignor. A motion to accept the minutes was made by Member Anstotz and seconded by Member Coolahan. The minutes passed by a unanimous vote.

1<sup>st</sup> Vice President/Cadet Trainer Gruccio: 15 cadets completed the 2022 course. 8 of which have completed their 6 hours of field training. The second meeting will be virtual,

on Monday, August 22, at 7:00 p.m. Kim spoke of the \$300.00 incentive for the new cadets, sponsored by NJSIAA.

2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President McCleary: Lisa indicated that 14 umpires received their ratings this summer.

She will contact and schedule ratings for the 10-12 umpires that need to be rated. Lisa reiterated that WC5 has set August 26<sup>th</sup> as the date to complete the test. NJSIAA will not close the test until 9/7/22. The answers to the test will be available on 9/8/22. The test has 55 questions. 50 of which are multiple choice.

The last 5 questions are video questions. In question 51, the umpire has blown the whistle. Even though NJSIAA set 80% as passing, WC5 requires a passing

grade of 86%. Should you score less than 86% contact Lisa.
